In 2021/22, the APM Hong Kong Branch registered the branch with the Hong Kong Police under the Societies Registration Ordinance. The APM Hong Kong Branch then rebranded as the APM Greater Bay Area Branch to connect the project communities of Hong Kong and the Greater Bay Area (GBA). We added 3 new committee members, and despite the continued COVID restrictions, we were able to host a number of webinars on project management as well as presentations to university and diploma students. Student membership in APM has seen some slight increase.

In 2022/23 we plan to continue hosting project management webinars and presentations to university students and young project professionals. We have also inaugurated the APM GBA Branch Awards for Student of the Year and Branch Emerging Professional. When the COVID restrictions are lifted we hope to resume in-person presentations, site visits, and corporate breakfasts/lunches.
