The APM Assurance SIG have just updated our Assurance Strategy and defined our roadmap for the next five years to ensure the SIG has a clear direction and is focused on our mission.

The Assurance SIG aim is to become the primary national source for the development, support and promotion for the project assurance profession. Our mission is to provide leadership through exchanging ideas, sharing good practice, and developing new approaches to providing project assurance.

Our SIG has been productive in 2021/22. We published an updated [*Measures for assuring projects*](#) and are in the process of finalising our *Guide to Project Auditing*. We have held four virtual meetups covering a range of diverse topics from Remote Control – Assurance Lessons from a Global Pandemic, to Rose Tinted Assurance – Looking at Optimism Bias in Assurance.

Next year, we will update our [*Guide to Integrated Assurance*](#) and we intend to include more examples and case studies to bring integrated assurance to life. We're also working on a collaborative conference with a number of other SIGS, in October, titled Driving Project Performance - Looking Forward.
